This book is focused not on interpreting the book of *Revelation*, that is what this podcast is for, but on accurately representing the book of *Revelation* in the manner in which the Spirit originally spoke it to John. In our last podcast, we discussed the Called and Chosen and Faithful. This is the bride of Christ and the ones who are with Him always. These are those to whom Jesus promised, "I will never leave you nor forsake you" and that "where I am you will also be." We discussed the pivotal conjunction that demands that we are born again, or converted, by God and that we dig down deep in our soul and choose to become a little child, one who is dependent upon **Yahweh** for all things all the time. This is what defines those who are Called and Chosen. But those who endure, no matter what Yahweh takes them through, these are those who are with Him: The Called and Chosen and Faithful.

EP147 Revelation 17 verse 15-18

The Great Judgment of the Harlot

Revelation 17:15-18

And he **now** says to me,

"The waters which you saw where the harlot now chooses to sit, are now peoples and multitudes and nations and tongues.

And the ten horns which you saw, and the Beast, these will in the future hate the harlot and cause her to being desolate will in the future make her naked and will in the future choose to eat her flesh and will in the **future** burn her up with fire.

For God has put it in their hearts to execute His purpose by having a common mind agreeing to give their kingdom to the Beast, until the words of God will in the future be caused to be fulfilled.

The woman whom you saw **now** is the great city, which is **now** reigning over the kings of the earth."

The Waters

The angel provides John additional detail about the image, and he now says, "The waters which you saw where the harlot now chooses to sit, are now peoples and multitudes and nations and tongues ..."1

According to the Code, this harlot sits not in one location, but all over this world. She does not have an

exclusive clientele. She prostitutes herself to whomever will have her, whomever is willing to pay the price. This phrasing, "peoples and multitudes and nations and tongues" is comprehensive. Sometimes she is found in a gathering, sometimes amongst a people group, and there are even entire countries and continents that have held her up as their ideal.

PEOPLE, THE WORLD OVER, SIMPLY LOVE RELIGION. THEY LOVE IDOLATRY. THEY LOVE ABOMINATIONS. THEY LOVE THE UNCLEAN THINGS OF HER IMMORALITY. IT MAKES THEM FEEL SO GOOD.

The Future Judgment of the Harlot by the Horns & the Beast

The Spirit first exposed us to the extent of this woman's harlotry so we will understand this next part of the revelation—the war that is waged against this woman and her idolatrous religion. We once spoke about the fact that according to the Code, horns are a symbol of strength and might. In this application, they are the henchman of the heads, the muscle of the higher spiritual kings/princes. As such, it is the horns (and not the heads) that lead the battle against the harlot, a battle which is guaranteed to have both spiritual and physical implications.

"And the ten horns which you saw, and the Beast, these will in the future hate the harlot and cause her to being desolate will in the **future** make her naked and will in the **future** choose to eat her flesh and will in the **future** burn her up with fire."

The Code also switches such that it predominantly utilizes the future tense; therefore, we can be sure that this is speaking of future events during the time of that infamous "hour." This is NOT happening now; this is a judgment reserved for the end.

Once again, the Beast is one of the seven heads, and his kingdom is not only the entire amalgamation of seven heads and 10-horns and the Beast, but he is also the little horn, i.e., the one who humbles himself, makes himself small or little, by entering a man. Collectively, these horns lead by the small horn "will in the **future** hate the harlot and cause her to being desolate will in the **future** make her naked and will in the **future** choose to eat her flesh and will in the **future** burn her up with fire."

It is important to note that "desolate" is not an adjective like "naked" but a verb that is rendered in the perfect passive participle. This means that her fate has been decreed sometime in the past, and she will be made desolate, or laid waste by these horns, and desolate will be her ongoing state of existence. In effect, she will be emptied out and permanently exiled. She once bragged that she is a Queen and will not be a widow and will never see mourning, but she was wrong. In the Codex, her demise was predicted with painful detail.

Isaiah 47:1-15

Come down and sit in the dust, O virgin daughter of Babylon; sit on the ground without a throne, O daughter of the Chaldeans! For you shall no longer be called tender and delicate. Take the millstones and grind meal. Remove your veil, strip off the skirt, uncover the leg, cross the rivers. Your nakedness will be uncovered, your shame also will be exposed; I will take vengeance and will not spare a man. Our Redeemer, Yahweh Sabaoth (the Lord of hosts) is His name, the Holy One of Israel.

Sit silently, and go into darkness, O daughter of the Chaldeans, for you will no longer be called the queen of kingdoms. I was angry with My people, I profaned My heritage and gave them into your hand. You did not show mercy to them, on the aged you made your yoke very heavy. Yet you said, 'I will be a queen forever.' These things you did not consider nor remember the outcome of them.

Now, then, hear this, you sensual one, who dwells securely, who says in your heart, 'I am, and there is no one besides me. I will not sit as a widow, nor know loss of children.' But these two things will come on you suddenly in one day: loss of children and widowhood. They will come on you in full measure in spite of your many sorceries, in spite of the great power of your spells.

You felt secure in your wickedness and said, 'No one sees me,' Your wisdom and your knowledge, they have deluded you; for you have said in your heart, 'I am, and there is no one besides me.' But evil will come on you which you will not know how to charm away; and disaster will fall on you for which you cannot atone; and destruction about which you do not know will come on you suddenly.

Stand fast now in your spells and in your many sorceries with which you have labored from your youth; perhaps you will be able to profit, perhaps you may cause trembling. You are wearied with your many counsels; let now the astrologers, those who prophesy by the stars, those who predict by the new moons, stand up and save you from what will come upon you. Behold, they have become like stubble, fire burns them; they cannot deliver themselves from the power of the flame; there will be no coal to warm by nor a fire to sit before! So have those become to you with whom you have labored, who have trafficked with you from your youth; each has wandered in his own way; there is none to save you.

This harlot thinks she is the bee's knees because she sits on top of the world with all those peoples, multitudes, nations, and tongues which she considers to be her children. She honestly believes she is untouchable. But she will be emptied, and these faithful followers will either abandon her or be burned like stubble.

The imagery is wicked: hate the harlot, make her be desolate and naked, eat her flesh, and burn her up with fire. The Spirit is clearly saying that there will be a total and universal judgment on the religions of this world which have prostituted themselves with idolatry and the worship of demons. They will be exposed for their lies and be violently ended. Quickly, suddenly, will be her demise. And this judgment will fall upon the religion of Christianity, Judaism, and all other religions who were convinced they were serving God by leading their people to try so hard to be good for God.

The 10 Horns and the Beast will hate the harlot and cause others to hate her as well. The fact that they will eat her flesh (which is crazy), seems to communicate that the Beast will consume or take over her substance. He will clothe himself with religion, his own blend, where he is not just one who facilitates and

directs worship, but he is the object of worship. And with his exaltation, her house will be abandoned, desolate. People will either leave her and worship the Best or they will die. And she will be stripped naked and exposed, the Best will disclose her delusion and the falsity of her ways. The promises she made to her captives cannot and will not be fulfilled. And she will be burned up with fire, everywhere she may be found in the world will literally be destroyed and made into a pile of soot. This is what hatred looks like.

It is God's Plan

"For God has put it in their hearts to execute His purpose by having a common mind agreeing to give their kingdom to the Beast, until the words of God will in the **future** be caused to be fulfilled." Once again, we are reminded that Jesus is Yahweh, the Lord (Adonai) God Almighty, the beginning and the end, the one who has not just the plan but the power to ensure His plans all come to fruition in exacting detail, a plan which no one can frustrate.

God Uses Evil to Punish Evil

In this text, we see that demonic beings are just tools in the hands of the Almighty. Yahweh will use them for His purposes and for His agenda. Yes, Yahweh uses evil to accomplish His purposes, which is why He created evil in the first place, to serve His purposes.

Isaiah 45:6-7

I am Yahweh, and there is no other, the One forming light and creating darkness, causing peace and creating evil; I am Yahweh who does all these.

Ironically, the horns will likely think that it is their plan, because God has put it in their hearts to do His will (to hate, to make desolate and naked, to eat her flesh, and to burn her up with fire) and to give their kingdom to the Beast. And these 10-kings, and the Beast, will act accordingly until the words of God "will in the **future** be caused to be fulfilled."

Isaiah 46:9-10

I am God, and there is no one like Me, declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times things which have not been done, saying, 'My purpose will be established, and I will accomplish all My good pleasure.'

Isaiah 43:13

Even from eternity I am He, and there is none who can deliver out of My hand; I act and who can

reverse it?"

Isaiah 14:26-27

This is the plan devised against the whole earth; and this is the hand that is stretched out against all the nations. For Yahweh Sabaoth (the Lord of hosts) has planned, and who can frustrate it? And as for His stretched-out hand, who can turn it back?

Job 9:12

Were He to snatch away, who could restrain Him? Who could say to Him, 'What are You doing?'

Think for a moment about the dynamic upon the earth. This man whom we call the Antichrist ascends to political and religious power and amasses a level of military might. Being possessed by the Beast who is himself possessed by miracle working demons, the Antichrist will work miracles and even claim to be God. At that point, he is "all-in," and he will go to war against anyone and any institution that suggests otherwise. After all, God did say that He created the Destroyer to ruin, or to pervert and to make desolate. And that is what he will do, right up to the point that he himself is destroyed with a complete destruction.³

These 10 kings will be of one-mind, and they will act with great violence. The physical impact of it all is detailed for us in *Revelation 18*, and it is a complete destruction. With that said, it is not clear exactly how this demonic force will manifest their will upon humanity, but they will cause peoples, multitudes, nations, and tongues to turn against the Harlot as they give themselves fully to the worship of their new Messiah, the Beast.

The Great City

Revelation 17:18

The woman whom you saw **now** is the great city, which is **now** reigning over the kings of the earth.

Being rendered in the present tense, she is even now reigning, or she now holds a position of royalty, and she now is the "great city." ⁴ This brings clarity to another part of the Revelation narrative, and that is regarding the tale of the two witnesses. If you remember, when the Beast is released from the Abyss, he will make war with the two witnesses and kill them. We are then told that "their dead body (a singular reference to the two witnesses) will lie in the great city which is now caused to be called mystically Sodom and Egypt, where also their Lord was caused to be crucified."5

The point was that in contrast to the narratives that claim the two witnesses are killed in Jerusalem, they are killed in this spiritual "great city" of religious apostasy (in mystery Babylon the Great), which has a worldwide populus, for this woman sits upon peoples, multitudes, nations, and tongues. Jesus was killed amongst the religious "faithful" of his day, and so too will the two witnesses be murdered in the great city. And their "dead body," that will be put on display before the peoples and tribes and tongues and nations, is a reference to the "body of Christ" comprised of Jewish and Gentile believers who collectively comprise one body and who individually are members of it.⁶ And that is why the Spirit specifically said "body" (singular) and not bodies (plural).

This woman is drunk with the blood of the saints, for her followers have and will be those who persecute and kill the "body of Christ" all the while convinced they are doing a service for God.

John 16:1-4

These things I have spoken to you so that you **may** be kept from being caused to stumble. They will in the **future** make you outcasts from the synagogue, but an hour chooses to **now** come for everyone who has been killing you may think that he **now** is offering service to God. These things they will in the **future** do because they have not known the Father or Me. But these things I have spoken to you, so that when their hour may come, you may **now** remember that I told you of them.

This woman, the great harlot, who chose to now be sitting on a scarlet beast full of blasphemous names having seven heads and ten horns, who now chooses to sit on many waters (peoples and multitudes and nations and tongues) is "the great city" and she now holds a position of royalty over all those who follow her seductions. **She is the embodiment of religious apostasy**, and it is through her harlotry that the blasphemous names, the misappropriation of the name of **Yahweh**, is prevalent all throughout the earth. She is Babylon the Great, the Mother of Harlots and of the Abominations of the Earth and her gold cup is full of abominations and of the unclean things of her immorality.

Kings of the Earth

"... The woman whom you saw **now** is the great city, which is **now** reigning over the kings of the earth." We have addressed this phrase, the "kings of the earth" previously in **Revelation 17:1-2** where the angel showed John the judgment of the great harlot. He said to John, "Come here, I will in the <u>future</u> show you the judgment of the great harlot who **now** chooses to be sitting on many waters with whom the kings of the earth committed acts of immorality..."

We were first introduced to this phrase "kings of the earth" in **Revelation 1:5** where we were told that Jesus, the firstborn of the dead, is the ruler or the prince of the "kings of the earth." This is a non-Hebraic way of saying that Jesus is **Yahweh Sabaoth** (the Lord of Hosts), the commander of the angelic forces, the Elohim, the gods, who have been given charge or rule over territories of the earth.

The "kings of the earth" are ruled by higher level Spirit Princes (the heads and the horns), but these kings have been assigned, by **Yahweh**, territory over which they rule humanity.

These "kings of the earth" are those mentioned in Psalm 2, along with the angelic "rulers," who take counsel together against Yahweh and His Anointed (which means the "Messiah" the "Christ"), saying, "Let us tear their fetters apart and cast their cords from us." The "kings of the earth" plot to gain their freedom from their master, their prince, their ruler, Yahweh Sabaoth. After all, it is likely that they too know the prophecy: "He will cut off the spirit princes; He is feared by the kings of the earth."

In every territory that these kings' rule, they have permitted the so called "gods" (who, as we have learned, are just demons in disguise) to be worshipped and honored within their territory.8 They have provided the platform for the demonic to introduce all manner of idolatry into the realms of humanity. This describes their "acts of immorality with the harlot."

Who knows, maybe these kings, like the seven heads, have taken on the form of a god to be worshipped by humanity. From the gods of Egypt to the golden cows of Samaria and Dan, to Apollo, Ares, Athena, Hera, Hermes, Zeus, to the pantheon of Hindu gods, to Allah, to Mary – the queen of heaven, to the thousands of incarnations of Jesus that are worshipped across the Religion of Christianity, these kings of the earth have joined with this harlot, the Woman who rides the Beast, and thereby committed acts of immorality.

The fact that this great harlot is now reigning over these kings tells us that this spirit of religious apostasy dictates obeisance from the kings of the earth, and they allow themselves to be ruled by her harlotries; after all, they committed acts of immorality with her, while those who dwell on the earth were made drunk with the wine of her immorality.

The Codex tells us that Yahweh will wreak havoc upon the angelic hosts who are in the heavens, but also upon those who reign on the earth—these "kings of the earth."

Isaiah 24:19-23

The earth is broken asunder, the earth is split through, the earth is shaken violently. The earth reels to and fro like a drunkard and it totters like a shack, for its transgression is heavy upon it, and it will fall, never to rise again. So, it will happen in that day, that Yahweh will punish the host of heaven on high, and the kings of the earth on earth. They will be gathered together like prisoners in the dungeon and will be confined in prison; and after many days they will be punished. Then the moon will be abashed and the sun ashamed, for Yahweh Sabaoth (the Lord of hosts) will reign on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem, and His glory will be before His elders.

Psalms 76:11-12

Make vows to Yahweh your God and fulfill them; let all who are around Him bring gifts to Him who is to be feared. He will cut off the spirit of princes; He is feared by the kings of the earth.

We know that the physical kings of the earth do not fear **Yahweh**, in fact, so many outright blaspheme and deny Him. But we know that the hosts (the armies) of heaven are terrified of their master and Lord, **Yahweh Sabaoth**.

Despite their fear, this woman of wickedness, this harlot, is so enticing and seductive, that she can demand obedience and demand that the rulers of mankind indulge in her immorality. And they continually imbibe helping fill up her cup of wickedness. Hence, she rides on their back and rules over them. Ultimately, she will ride upon the back of the Beast until the fateful day when the kingdom of the Beast will turn on her and destroy her.

Review of Heads and Horns

The Kingdom of the Beast was previously imaged as a great mountain burning with fire that is thrown into the sea of humanity. We have discovered that this kingdom is comprised of seven heads, which are seven spiritual Princes or Kings who are the strategic leaders of this demonic kingdom.

This Kingdom of seven heads, or seven kings, also has 10-horns, or 10-spiritual authorities whose purposes is to attack and defend. The seven heads will use these 10-horns to interface with, and to bully, overpower, dominate, and to crush mankind. These spiritual authorities, however, are not released upon humanity until the Beast is released upon the earth. Their authority as Kings is tied to the time in which the Beast is unleashed upon the earth, and even then, only for one hour.

Jesus spoke about the "hour of testing" that would come upon the whole world to test those who are now dwelling on the earth. ¹⁰ And an angel flying in mid heaven having the eternal gospel to preach said with a loud voice, "You are commanded to be caused to fear God, and you are commanded to give Him glory, for the hour of His judgment has come." ¹¹

Sticking to the **Code**, their authority to function as kings, impacting this world, will be only for the time of testing, which will be after the first harvest, which is a reference to the rapture of the church.¹² This is in line with the fact that Jesus promised the church at Philadelphia that they would be kept from the "hour of testing" that is now coming upon the whole world.¹³

This time is also correlated with the "one hour" in which the judgment of Babylon, the great city, comes. In one hour, her great wealth is laid to waste, yes in one hour she is laid waste by the ten horns and the Beast.¹⁴

Prior to his release from the Abyss, the kingdom of the Beast is first prepared for the Beast, the angelic spirit whose name is the Destroyer or Destruction. This assembly of heads and horns (angelic powers) is put into place and comes to prominence in the sea of humanity with fire and furry. Then when he is released from the Abyss, the Destroyer joins the 7 heads (as an 8th) and takes up his leadership and reigns over this kingdom.

However, when he rises to power, with violence, he will cause three of the horns that were affixed to the seven heads to be uprooted. So, there will still be seven heads ruling this kingdom, but ultimately only eight horns as the Beast functions as the "little horn" of Daniel, as an interface with mankind that opposes and crushes the people of God. And since eight is the number of new beginnings, a number connected to the Messiah, he will be the ultimate poser convincing the world that he is their promised Messiah.

At first, this kingdom allows the Harlot who is now sitting on many waters to ride upon it. Therefore, we should expect to see those ruling this kingdom, and the man we call the Antichrist, to utilize religion to assist in their quest for power, rule, and authority. We are told in the Codex that spirit of the Beast has taken his seat in the "naos" (the holy place of the temple of God), and it is there amongst the people of God that he now declares he now is God. 15 The spirit behind this man of lawlessness is already at work amongst the people of God, and those who do not choose to receive the love the truth so as to be caused to be saved, are now choosing to perish with the Beast.

Accordingly, the people of God, the Called and Chosen and Faithful, need to be alert, awake, and properly clothed so they will not walk around naked, and so others will not see their shame if they fail to recognize this deceiver. 16
